The Transatlantic Music Project, is a collaborative chamber music gorup made up of students from The Juilliard School in New York and the Cologne Academy of Music and Dance. For 10 days in October, the group will bring five outstanding students from Cologne and eight from The Juilliard School to New York City to participate in rehearsals with joint ensembles.

The students will have the privilege of receiving coaching from internationally renowned teachers, including Lewis Kaplan and Charles Neidich of The Juilliard School in New York, as well as Ariadne Daskalakis and Nina Tichman of the Cologne Academy of Music and Dance.

The joint ensembles from New York and Cologne will present two spectacular concerts in New York this month. The German Consulate General will host a concert on Tuesday, October 16 at 6 p.m., and the Juilliard School of Dance, Drama, and Music will host a second concert on Friday, October 19 at 8 p.m. in Paul Hall. Tuesday's program will include violin duos by Lucian Berio and Bela Bartok, a clarinet quintet by W.A. Mozart, and Johannes Brahms' g minor piano quartet.
